

All Funeral Directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options, make choices, and to let you compare prices between funeral directors.

This Standardised Price List is in line with the Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) requirements.

## ATTENDED FUNERAL

(Funeral Director's Charges Only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend the burial or cremation.

• Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£	2270.00
• Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death into our care (normally within 15 mile radius).	£	635.00
• Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at our premises in Milton Road, Weymouth.	£	330.00
• Providing a suitable coffin – this will be an oak wood effect veneer style.	£	265.00
• Viewing of the deceased for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director.	£	515.00
• At a date and time agreed with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed crematorium or cemetery (normally within 20 miles of the Funeral Director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£	5.00

## UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

• Burial (Funeral Director's Charges only).	£	1350.00
• Cremation (Funeral Director's Charges plus Cremation fee) <sup>2</sup> .	£	1995.00

## FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended Burial, the **Burial Fee**: <sup>1</sup>.

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for a local resident is:

<b>Portland</b>	£	800.00

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot: for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

## ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR'S PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

The Funeral Director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

The Funeral Director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales & Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign Medical Certificates for Cremation.
